#563 World Missions

Isaiah 60:1-5; Matthew 28: 19-20; Romans 10:11-15

LEADER: Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee.

CONG: For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the Lord shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

LEADER: And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

CONG: Lift up thine eyes round about, and see: all they gather themselves together, they come to thee: thy sons shall come from far, and thy daughters shall be nursed at thy side.

LEADER: Then thou shalt see, and flow together, and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged; because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto thee, the forces of the Gentiles shall come unto thee.

CONG: Go ye therefore, and teach all nation, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

LEADER: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world, Amen.

CONG: For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

LEADER: For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him.

CONG: For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

LEADER: How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?

ALL: And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!
